After the deadlines, acceptance of your evidence or payment is at the discretion of the course admission team.

If you'll be studying a pre-sessional English language course, please check the [Language Centre website](#) for the deadlines that are in place relating to your offer.

Meeting the deadlines doesn't guarantee that you'll be able to arrive in time for the start of your course. For this reason, you're advised to accept your offer and pay the deposit or provide appropriate funding evidence, if applicable, as soon as possible. It's your responsibility to ensure you have enough time to apply for a visa, travel to the UK and commence your studies on time.

We reserve the right not to issue a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) for your Student visa application if there won't be enough time for you to arrive in Leeds by the latest possible start date for your course.

Changing your start date

If you can't start the course this year and would like to join us for a future intake instead, you'll need to reapply as we don't permit deferrals. Applications usually open each October for courses starting in the next academic year.
